Submission Guidelines:

- **Manuscript Length:** Submissions should not exceed 8000 words, including references, notes, and appendices (MLA 9th Edition).
- **Formatting:** Manuscripts should be prepared according to the guidelines mentioned on the website of *Urdu Studies*.
- Language: Submissions should be in English or Urdu. Urdu texts and translations may be included where relevant. Transliteration rules of *Urdu Studies* should be followed strictly.
- **Abstract:** Please include an abstract of no more than 200 words with your submission.
- **Review Process:** All submissions will undergo an open peer-review process (OPR).

- Final Manuscript Submission: 15th of July, 2025
